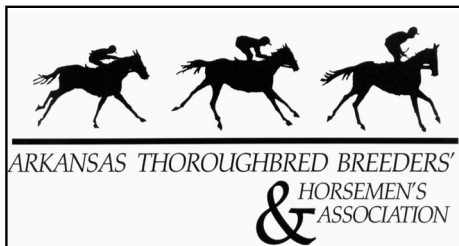

## OAKLAWN ANNOUNCES 2019 STAKES

In addition to Oaklawn Jockey Club announcing a change of dates for the 2019 live race meet, it announced the 2019 stakes schedule will consist of \$8.8 million in stakes purses to include two \$1 million Kentucky Derby prep races, the Grade 2 Rebel and the Grade 1 Arkansas Derby.

The stakes schedule also features 3 year old stakes races on opening and closing days and Derby Day observances in April and May. April being the Arkansas Derby, May the Kentucky Derby.

New to Oaklawn's stakes schedule for 2019 are the \$200,000 Oaklawn Mile for 4-year-olds and up that will run May 3rd and the \$200,000 Arkansas Breeders' Championship, a 1 1/16 mile race on May 4 for state-bred 3-year-olds and up. The restricted Arkansas-bred stakes schedule is shown on page 10.

In 2013 at the age of 21, Kelsi Harr began working for Al Cates as an exercise rider. She continued in that position until 2018 when she began to accrue a string of firsts during the 25th year of her life.

At the end of March 2018 Kelsi took the test to become an assistant trainer and passed it on her very first attempt. She continued to ride in the mornings and saddled in the afternoons for Al Cates Racing. She received her first win as an assistant trainer on the third horse that she saddled at Oaklawn Park, Bella My Girl, for owner J & J Thoroughbreds

(Joe & Jeannie Benight).

From there Kelsi went to Canterbury Park where she applied for and received her first license as a jockey. Her first career win came on her first try - first mount! It just happened to be on father's day! Robert Cline and

Lacey, daughter of Robert & Kelsi, watched along side Kelsi's parents, as Bandit Point, the horse Robert trained for Glendyl Price was ridden to victory by Kelsi.

Bandit Point is a registered Arkansas-bred by Indy Squall - out of Set Point.

Al Cates, Robert Cline, and Glendyl Price are all members of A.T.B.H.A.

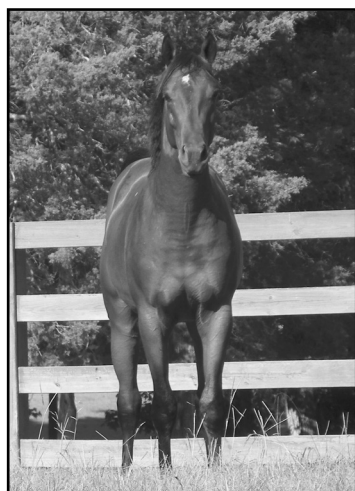

#### **Horse Racing Reform Launches New Website**

Horse Racing Reform, an industry initiative led by The Jockey Club and Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association, announced today the launch of an updated website, [horseracingreform.org](http://horseracingreform.org), designed to better inform and educate the general public, racing fans, and industry personnel on safety, integrity, and welfare matters in horse racing.

The mobile-friendly site includes a range of new educational tools and resources to keep users apprised of advocacy efforts. Among the additions to the website:

- Updated maps showing adoption of model rule language for out-of-competition testing, third-party Lasix administration, and controlled therapeutic medication thresholds
- Updated map and in-depth summary showing adoption of the National Uniform Medication Program
- An "Education" section dedicated to providing information on equine health and safety
- A regular blog from Joe Gorajec, former executive director of the Indiana Horse Racing Commission and a longtime advocate for integrity in racing
- Links to state rulebooks and commission websites
- A searchable list of Lasix-free runners from the prior 30 days
- A live Twitter feed

"The stated mission of the Horse Racing Reform initiative is to provide awareness and education to the racing community to advocate for increased uniformity, safety, welfare, and integrity of the sport," said Matt Iuliano, executive vice president and executive director, The Jockey Club. "This new and improved website will provide invaluable resources for fellow advocates to stay informed and engaged as we work to improve the industry, specifically through passage of the Horseracing Integrity Act of 2017."

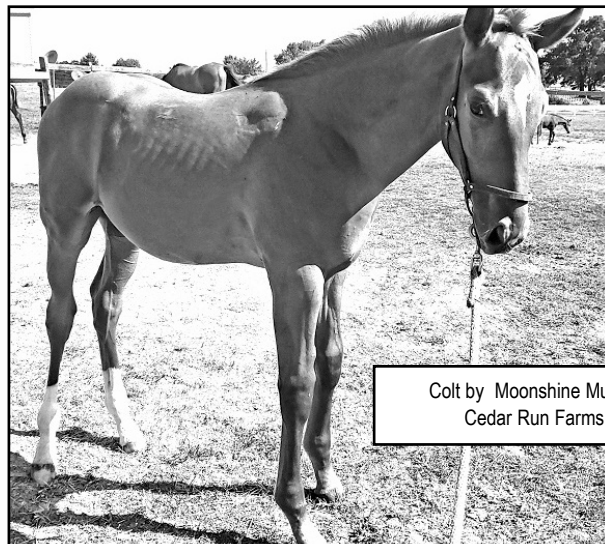

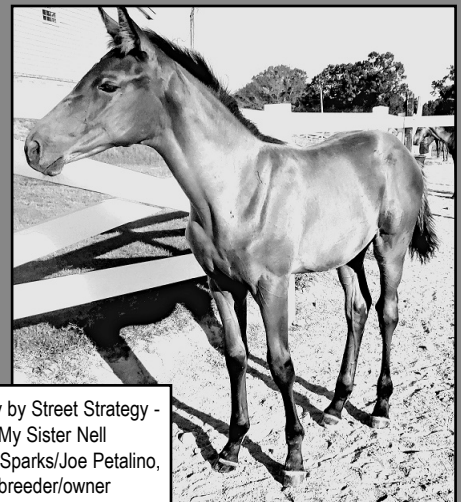

# MINUTES OF MEETINGS OF BOARD OF DIRECTORS OF ARKANSAS THOROUGHBRED BREEDERS & HORSEMEN'S ASSOCIATION

A meeting of the Board of Directors of Arkansas Thoroughbred Breeders' & Horsemen's Association was held Wednesday, March 21, 2018 at 1:30 p.m. at the ATBHA office in Hot Springs, Arkansas.

President McDowell called the meeting to order. Directors in attendance were Bill McDowell, Lewis Mathews, Jr., Joe Benight, Jesse Clement, Tommy Ives, Jeff Sheets, and Val Yagos, constituting a quorum. Not present was Linda Anderson, Tim Martin, Sara Patterson and Ernie Witt. President McDowell announced that a quorum was present.

President McDowell asked if there were any corrections or discussion regarding the Minutes from the January 31, 2018 meeting. There being none, Tommy Ives made a motion to approve the minutes as written, seconded by Lewis Mathews, and unanimously approved.

President McDowell announced that the legislative auditors had completed the 2017 awards audit two weeks ago and the files were at the Racing Commission in Little Rock for checks to be processed and mailed. He further stated checks were being mailed this week. He asked if there were any questions pertaining to the 2017 Purse & Awards Fund Distribution report. There being none, he continued with the meeting.

The next item was consideration of email correspondence dated March 5, 2018 from Billy Welch, breeder of Regalistic, and a letter from Linda Robbins dated February 21, 2018, both with varying requests regarding the Regalistic matter. There was discussion among the directors that the Welch's request had previously been addressed, voted on, and approved in the Minutes of the January 31, 2018. Any further action regarding the Welch request died for lack of any new Motion; likewise, no action was taken regarding the Robbins' letter.

President McDowell announced Jesse Ullery would be our featured guest speaker at the annual awards banquet.

Next was discussion regarding 2019 purses and races at Oaklawn. After discussion, Joe Benight made a motion to raise all stakes purses to \$125,000 with Oaklawn splitting the purses 50/50, as in all previous stakes, Val Yagos seconded the motion. A vote was taken and the Motion passed unanimously.

Joe Benight then made a motion to ask Oaklawn to bring back the Arkansas Breeders' Stakes (filly division) to be run at a distance of 1 mile to 1 1/16 mile, seconded by Val Yagos and unanimously approved.

Next was discussion regarding changes to existing rules and regulations and the registration forms. Several ideas were mentioned. It was agreed that each director should review the existing rules, regulations and forms and bring with them to the next meeting ideas to be considered regarding new procedures for verifying and certifying locations where mares are foaling and any requirements and procedures concerning same.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned.
