Plane makes emergency landing at Double M Stables!

A small plane made an emergency landing in the infield of the racetrack at Double M Stables on October 2nd. A vintage plane arrived at Hot Springs Memorial Field the morning before, pilot spent the night in Hot Springs that evening and took off the next afternoon.

Apparently the engine began giving the pilot issues, so he put it down. John Ward, former ATBHA Member, and thoroughbred owner and trainer who owns property and a restaurant, Ward's Crawling center was outside the restaurant when he heard the plane go over the top of the racetrack. He said he knew something wasn't right,



then the plane came back headed in the opposite direction extremely low. Ward said he could almost touch the wheels so he immediately called a friend at Double M Stables and warned them that a plane was going down and appeared to be headed to their infield. Sure enough, the plane was a little sideways coming in, but it went down pretty smooth, had a successful landing ... and that was it!

Rayana, Registered Arkansas-bred Juvenile Winner at Del Mar for Bob Baffert

Rayana, (f, 2, Scat Daddy-Tipping Point, by Speightstown), bred in Arkansas by James W. Matheney, Jr., sold in 2017 for \$130,000 at the Keeneland September yearling sale by her breeder, and then sold again in 2018 at the Tattersalls Two-Year-Old Sale for \$361,318 to Sheikh Rashid Bin Humaid Al Nuaimi. This Arkansas-bred filly was then handed over to Bob Baffert for training.



In a MSW with a purse of \$60,000, Rayana showed speed from her outside draw and never looked back, taking them all the way and giving Bob Baffert a rare turf juvenile winner on closing day at Del Mar. This Arkansas-bred showed a steady string of stamina - building works for this unveiling, capped by a six-furlong spin in 1:14 flat (3/3) on the local main in August 28th. Given a 3-1 chance, this dark bay broke sharply and pulled her way to the front, leading clear through fractions of :22.97 and :46.98. Held together strongly by leading rider Drayden Van Dyke, an Arkansas native and graduate from Lake Hamilton High School in Pearcy, Arkansas, she turned for home with her ears pricked, lengthened her stride to create an unassailable advantage and came home a 1 1/4-length victress over odds-on favorite. The running time for the mile was 1:35.98, which was 1.19 seconds faster than 'TDN Rising Star' Summering (War Front) ran in taking the Del Mar Juvenile Fillies Turf S. four races earlier.

New Registration forms are posted on ATBHA's website to be used for all future registrations beginning immediately. If you have any problems downloading the application(s) you can email, call or fax the ATBHA office and the form(s) needed will be emailed or mailed to you.

Along with the new forms, minor changes have been made to the Rules and Regulations of Arkansas Thoroughbred Breeders' & Horsemen's Association, as proposed by their Board of Directors and approved by the Arkansas Racing Commission, most changes being to a Broodmare's registration.

The Rules and Regulations, along with the applicable fees for each, are printed on the back of the application specific to the type of registration (Broodmare, Sire or Arkansas-bred Foal). If you have any questions, contact the ATBHA office.

RICHARD P. HOGUE, JR. Recognized for Accomplishments

A familiar face in Hope, AR was among those honored in August during a special ceremony in Little Rock for the state's "Senior Arkansas Hall of Fame."

Richard Hogue, the 2012 Citizen of the Year as recognized by the Hope/Hempstead Chamber of Commerce, received a Certificate of Appreciation at the Senior Arkansans Hall of Fame as sponsored by the Arkansas Department of Human Services Division of Aging, Adult, and Behavioral Health Services. Hogue was nominated to the Seniors Hall of Fame in July.

After returning from Little Rock Hogue said, "This is a great honor and a great surprise. It only could have been better had they made a certificate for two."

"Two" of course, is in reference to his wife, Rosetta, who Richard has been married to for 60 years, and who is equally well-known and loved in the Hope community having been by Richard's side through the years and his many accomplishments, both in his business and his charitable works.



Hogue's most noted effort as documented in the Hope Star was his "Hope for Joplin" campaign to send relief and aid to tornado victims in Joplin, Missouri in 2012. Through the Hogues efforts, "Hope for Joplin" raised over \$50,000 locally for the Joplin victims and delivered two semi-truck trailer loads of food and bedding supplies to those who lost everything. In May 2011 Joplin tornado was then known as one of the deadliest and most costly tornadoes in US history.

Hogue's story as a retired service station owner and operator for 50 years has also been well chronicled over the years as well as his efforts to assist needy patients with kidney transplants and victims of drug and domestic abuse.

In retirement, Hogue also raised competitive race horses and is well-known in the state's horse racing culture.

The Certificate of Appreciation was presented by Ronda Gilbert-Hines, a Deputy Director of the Arkansas Department of Human Services of Aging, Adult, and Behavioral Health Services.

ATBHA RULES AND REGISTRATION CHANGES

The ATBHA Board of Directors recently reviewed the Rules & Regulations of Arkansas Thoroughbred Breeders' & Horsemen's Association, specifically rules governing registration of Stallions, Broodmares and Foals in Arkansas. At their last meeting suggested changes were discussed, voted on and approved for presentation to the Arkansas Racing Commission as is required by law. At the September meeting of the ARC, the rules with proposed changes were approved and became effective immediately.

Only minor grammatical and punctuation changes were made to the Stallion and Foal Registration Applications; no changes to the substance of the rules.

The Broodmare Registration rules with approved changes are:

III. BROODMARE REGISTRATION.

A. A broodmare in foal by a stallion not registered as an Arkansas Stallion who is brought into Arkansas for the purpose of foaling and registering her foal as a Registered Arkansas-bred must be reported by the broodmare owner or agent at the time of her arrival in Arkansas prior to foaling by completing and filing an Application for Registration of Broodmare with ATBHA, accompanied by a copy of the broodmare's Jockey Club Certificate of Foal Registration, including the section showing ownership transfers, and payment of broodmare registration fee together with current ATBHA membership dues, if not previously paid.

B. In order for a mare to be registered with ATBHA as a "registered Arkansas thoroughbred broodmare", her registration with ATBHA must be accomplished (1) as stated in section III. A. above, or (2) If section III. A. above is not applicable, prior to foaling the foal for which the registration as an "Arkansas-bred thoroughbred horse" is sought.

C. To register a broodmare as a "registered Arkansas-bred thoroughbred broodmare" an Application for Registration of Broodmare must be completed and filed with ATBHA prior to foaling, accompanied by a copy of the broodmare's Jockey Club Certificate of Foal Registration, including the

section showing ownership transfers, and payment of broodmare registration fee together with current ATBHA membership dues, if not previously paid.

D. A broodmare will remain registered and her owner shall be entitled to Breeder's Awards based on the earnings of her registered Arkansas-bred progeny until said broodmare changes ownership. If a broodmare is sold or otherwise changes ownership, the new owner must re-register said broodmare into his/her name prior to foaling in order for that broodmare's registration status to remain uninterrupted and to be entitled to Breeder's Awards based on the earnings of her registered Arkansas-bred progeny foaled during his ownership.

It is imperative that broodmares coming into the State of Arkansas be registered when the mare is brought into the state, prior to the foal being born.

Registration Application are available on the ATBHA web-site.

If at any time anyone has a question regarding a registration or registration rule they can contact the ATBHA office by email, through the ATBHA website, by fax, by phone or by mail for clarification and/or verification.

The ATBHA rules and changes will be strictly enforced and followed. Failure to comply may cause a registration to be ineligible, VOID or late, costing additional fees.

Also, **SUBMIT STAKES NOMINATIONS OF 2017 FOALS BY DECEMBER 31st!** Make sure you attach a copy (front and back showing ownership transfers) of The Jockey Club Certificate for all broodmare and sire registrations. Failure to do this could cause a delay and result in your registration being late.
