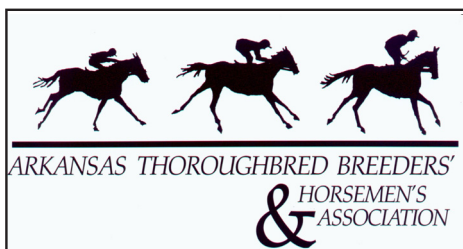

2020 Restricted Stakes Purses Increase

Oaklawn's 2020 season begins Friday, Jan. 24, and continues through Saturday, May 2. The 57-day season will feature 33 stakes races worth a total of \$10,700,000. Of the 33 races 15 received purse increases including four Arkansas-bred stakes. The Downthedustroad Breeders', Nodouble Breeders', Rainbow, and Rainbow Miss purses were each increased from \$100,000 to \$125,000. The purse of the Arkansas Breeders' Championship will remain at \$200,000. The entire 2020 stakes schedule is printed on page 10.

The Jockey Club Projects Foal Crop of 20,500 in 2020

The Jockey Club Projects Foal Crop of 20,500 in 2020

The Jockey Club is projecting a 2020 North American registered Thoroughbred foal crop of 20,500.

The Jockey Club also announced a revision to the 2019 foal crop from 21,500 to 20,800. This adjustment is based on the number of Live Foal Reports received to date for the 2019 foaling year.

The foal crop projection, traditionally announced in mid-August, is computed by using Reports of Mares Bred (RMBs) received to date for the 2019 breeding season. RMBs are to be filed by August 1 of each breeding season.

"We estimate that approximately 80% of reports of mares bred, which the foal crop estimate is based on, have been received," said Matt Iuliano, The Jockey Club's executive vice president and executive director.

Additional foal crop information is available in The Jockey Club's online fact book at jockeyclub.com/factbook.asp and in the online state fact books.

Stallion owners who have not returned their RMBs for the 2019 breeding season are encouraged to do so as soon as possible. Interactive Registration, which enables registered users to perform virtually all registration-related activities over the Internet, is the most efficient means of submitting RMBs and is available at registry.jockeyclub.com.

Oaklawn Announces 2020 Stakes Schedule

Oaklawn announced their 2020 stakes schedule. Highlighted by four \$1 million stakes races – the \$1 million Rebel Stakes (G2), \$1 million Arkansas Derby (G1), \$1 million Oaklawn Handicap (G2) and \$1 million Apple Blossom Handicap (G1).

Their announcement further stated:

"In addition, the richest Kentucky Derby and Kentucky Oaks prep series in the country just got richer with significant bumps to the Southwest Stakes (G3), Honeybee Stakes (G3) and Fantasy Stakes (G3).

"We have so many great things happening now at Oaklawn and it's reflected in our remarkable stakes program scheduled for the 2020 season," Oaklawn President Louis Cella said. "We are especially proud of the increases we made to our 3-year-old series for horses on the Kentucky Derby and Kentucky Oaks trail."

Oaklawn's rich 3-year-old program for colts and geldings begins opening day, Jan. 24, with the \$150,000 Smarty Jones Stakes and culminates closing day, May 2, with the \$300,000 Oaklawn Invitational, which is returning to the schedule following a successful debut in 2019. In between, are the \$750,000 Southwest Stakes, the Presidents' Day Monday feature, which has received a \$250,000 increase over 2019, the Rebel Stakes March 14 and the Arkansas Derby April 11.

Rebel Stakes weekend also will feature three other stakes, including the inaugural \$125,000 Temperence Hill Stakes March 13 for 4-year-olds and up at 1 ½ miles. The race is named in honor of the 1980 champion 3-year-old who won the Rebel, Arkansas Derby and Belmont Stakes (G1), before returning the following year to win the Oaklawn Handicap.

Oaklawn has boosted the purses of all three races in its 3-year-old fillies series in 2020 starting with a \$25,000 increase to the \$150,000 Martha Washington Stakes Feb. 1. Both the \$300,000 Honeybee Stakes March 7 and the \$600,000 Fantasy Stakes April 10 received \$100,000 increases.

The Racing Festival of the South kicks off April 10 with the Fantasy Stakes and is followed the next day, April 11, with the Arkansas Derby and three other stakes – the \$200,000 Carousel Stakes, \$250,000 Oaklawn Mile and \$500,000 Count Fleet Sprint Handicap (G3). The Carousel for filly and mare sprinters received a \$50,000 increase and joins the Derby Day card for the first time.

For the first time in Oaklawn history, the Racing Festival of the South continues past the Arkansas Derby and will conclude the following Saturday, April 18, with the \$1 million Oaklawn Handicap and \$1 million Apple Blossom Handicap. The Oaklawn Handicap for 4-year-olds and up and the Apple Blossom for older fillies and mares both received an increase of \$250,000 over their 2019 purses.

"My father conceived the idea for the Racing Festival of the South in 1974 and since that time it's become one of the most prominent events on the national racing calendar," Cella said. "I think he would be thrilled to see the purses of the Oaklawn Handicap and Apple Blossom at \$1 million each."

MICROCHIPS AND MICROCHIP SCANNERS

Thoroughbred owners and breeders can now order microchip scanners directly from Pet Travel through a link on The Jockey Club's Interactive Registration page at:

The Datamars Compact Max Universal Scanner, which is manufactured by Datamars and marketed and distributed by Pet Travel, is available for \$249. (Recently a slight discount has been given for orders to individuals with The Jockey Club affiliation.)

In August 2015, The Jockey Club's board of stewards voted to change certain provisions of the Principle Rules and Requirements of the American Stud Book and microchips will become a requirement for registration for foals of 2017 and later. This enables microchips to be phased in on a voluntary basis for foals of 2016 and enables breeders and owners to establish appropriate procedures with their veterinarian and identifier and to acquire a microchip reader.

"Countries such as England, Ireland, France, South Africa, Australia, and others have instituted microchips as a requirement for registration for several years now," said Rick Bailey, The Jockey Club registrar. "Identifiers at the various racetracks in North America have also reported the microchip to be reliable in confirming identity from the runners importing from Europe, Asia, and other parts of the world."

Microchips are available upon request on a live foal report for 2016 foals and will be distributed for all 2017 foals. There is no increase to the registration fee for either foal crop.

When coupled with the review for written markings, the use of microchips improves the efficiency and reliability of the identification process for all Thoroughbreds, even for those who do not make it to the racetrack.

The Jockey Club recommends that microchips be implanted by a veterinarian or under the supervision of a veterinarian.

A FOAL BORN IN THE STATE OF ARKANSAS IS AN "ARKANSAS-BRED FOAL"

A FOAL BORN IN THE STATE OF ARKANSAS and WHOSE DAM & SIRE ARE BOTH CORRECTLY REGISTERED WITH THE A.T.B.H.A. or WHOSE DAM IS CORRECTLY REGISTERED WITH A.T.B.H.A. and WHOSE SIRE IS NOT A REGISTERED ARKANSAS STALLION, BUT ALL A.T.B.H.A. BREED-BACK RULES TO THE DAM HAVE BEEN MET~ IS A "REGISTERED ARKANSAS-BRED FOAL"

IF YOU SELL A MARE WHOSE LAST REGISTERED ARKANSAS-BRED FOAL WAS SIRED BY A STALLION NOT REGISTERED IN ARKANSAS AND THE MARE HAS NOT BEEN OR WAS NOT BRED BACK THE YEAR OF FOALING, THE BREED BACK RULE TRANSFERS WITH THE SALE OF THE MARE.

THAT RULE STATES ... IN THE CASE OF A REGISTERED ARKANSAS THOROUGHBRED BROODMARE IN FOAL TO AN OUT-OF-STATE STALLION, THE FOAL MAY BE REGISTERED AS AN ARKANSAS-BRED THOROUGHBRED HORSE PROVIDED THE FOAL IS FOALED IN ARKANSAS, AND (I) THE MARE IS BRED BACK IN THE SAME CALENDAR YEAR TO AN ARKANSAS REGISTERED STALLION ONLY, OR (II) THE MARE DIES PRIOR TO BEING BRED BACK IN THE SAME CALENDAR YEAR TO AN ARKANSAS REGISTERED STALLION, OR (III) MARE IS NOT BRED AT ALL DURING THE CALENDAR YEAR THE FOAL IS FOALED, BUT IS BRED TO AN ARKANSAS REGISTERED STALLION ONLY THE FOLLOWING YEAR.

A Message from our President:

By now, I'm sure you have read and/or heard that the four Arkansas-bred stakes race purses were increased to \$125,000 beginning. With the Arkansas Champions Stakes at \$200,000 that will bring our stakes purse total to \$700,000 for 2020.

Arkansas lost a major owner and breeder of thoroughbreds when Richard Hogue passed this month. Richard and Rosetta bred and raced many Arkansas-bred stakes winners. Most were out of mares they had raised. They bred mares in Kentucky to improve their stock and were successful. He loved the racing and breeding and helped our association in the process.

The hot weather we've had lately is tough on some of the horses. I've had a couple mares that needed extra attention to keep them from getting too hot. If their hair coat is dull or they have hair loss on their back or hips, these are signs of heat problems. Not sweating properly is usually the problem and the mares are different all the time, some hot days they are fine, other days they are not, so keep an eye on things during this heat!

I can't wait to see all of the new additions to Oaklawn. I know Deana will be glad to get settled back into the ATBHA office. She's been working out of a small office at Oaklawn without all of her normal equipment, files, etc.

The construction site literally changes daily, but I'm sure it's still not fast enough for Oaklawn considering the horses will begin arriving in three fast months.
