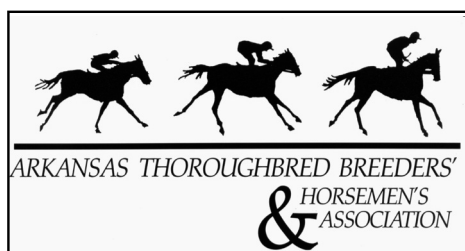

2021 Restricted Stakes Purses

The ATBHA Board of Directors voted unanimously to increase the purses of the Rainbow Stakes, Rainbow Miss Stakes, Downthedustyroad Breeders' Stakes and the Nodouble Breeders' Stakes from \$125,000 to \$150,000 in 2021. The Arkansas Breeders' Championship purse will remain at \$200,000.

Oaklawn also increased the purses of stakes that ran for \$125,000 in 2020 to \$150,000 so the minimum stakes purse will be \$150,000 beginning in 2021.

Information regarding the 2021 purse structure of the remaining 2021 races will be in the 4th Quarter issue of *The ATBHA News*.

If you don't have an account with THE JOCKEY CLUB ("TJC") INTERACTIVE REGISTRATION ("IR"), you absolutely need one if you're in the thoroughbred business. It's simple to sign up and it's totally FREE!

Once you have set up your account and look through it, you'll understand why we stress that you have to have one. Your Jockey Club Certificates are no longer mailed to you. TJC issues digital certificates that are placed in your account. You won't ever lose your Jockey Club Certificates again. You have total control of the assignment of who gets the digital copy of a certificate (ie. your trainer, a racing secretary, sales company, etc.).

We also stress that once Arkansas Thoroughbred Breeders' has put the Registered Arkansas-bred stamp on your foal's digital certificate showing it is a "Registered Arkansas-bred" that you print a copy of the certificate so you have a paper copy of the Jockey Club's digital certificate for your file.

We also suggest that you watch TJC's instructional video on digital certificates.

Digital Certificate - Frequently Asked Questions

Answers to Frequently Asked Questions about Digital Certificate

1. How will I receive my Digital Certificate(s)?

When you log on to your Jockey Club Interactive Registration account, you will see an option under DIGITAL CERTIFICATES labeled CERTIFICATE MANAGEMENT that will display the certificates currently assigned to your Interactive Registration account.

2. Who is assigned the Digital Certificate?

Digital Certificates are assigned to a Certificate Manager, a person or entity authorized to control the disposition of a Digital Certificate. The Certificate Manager may or may not be the owner of the horse.

3. How will I forward my Digital Certificate to a sales company, racetrack, or other entity that requires the Certificate of Foal Registration?

The Certificate Manager will be able to assign the certificate to another party by selecting the appropriate entity or person, clicking the button that says "Assign Certificate," and then following the prompts to complete the assignment.

4. How will I know when a Digital Certificate has been assigned to my account?

An email notification will be sent shortly after a digital certificate(s) has been assigned to your Interactive Registration account.

5. Will all of my horses be issued a Digital Certificate?

Foals of 2018 and after will be issued Digital Certificates.

6. What if a mistake was made when assigning a Digital Certificate?

If a mistake was made when assigning a Digital Certificate the assignor should contact The Jockey Club for assistance at inquiries@jockeyclub.com.

7. How can I determine the current Digital Certificate Manager of a Thoroughbred?

When you log on to your Jockey Club Interactive Registration account, you will see an option under **REGISTRATION** labeled **CHECK REGISTRATION STATUS** that will display the current Digital Certificate Manager for foals of 2018 and later.

8. Does the ownership data recorded with the assignment of a Digital Certificate prove title to the horse?

No. The Jockey Club is a pedigree registry for Thoroughbred horses, not an ownership or title registry. Accordingly, any information presented by The Jockey Club concerning the "owner" of a horse is based solely upon information provided by others and is in no way warranted or otherwise offered by The Jockey Club as being a representation of who the actual owner or title holder of a particular Thoroughbred is..

THOROUGHBRED SAFETY COMMITTEE ANNOUNCES 2020 RECOMMENDATIONS

The Thoroughbred Safety Committee today announced three new recommendations to the industry to further improve the health, welfare, and safety of its equine athletes.

The recommendations call for:

- Increased self-reporting statistics from the Equine Injury Database
- Mandatory stand-down period for horses in the care of trainers determined to be in possession of or intending to administer illegal substances to racehorses
- Banning the presence of clenbuterol in Thoroughbred racehorses and Thoroughbreds consigned for public auction

The recommendations resulted from a meeting of the Thoroughbred Safety Committee held March 17 in Lexington, Ky., and via teleconference. The full text of the recommendations can be found on The Jockey Club website at jockeyclub.com/default.asp?section=Advocacy&area=14.

"As with most of the world, our industry is facing challenges from the COVID-19 pandemic, but it is also facing challenges from within," said Craig Fravel, chairman of the Thoroughbred Safety Committee and chief executive officer, Racing Operations, The Stronach Group. "At this critical time, it is more important than ever that we ensure our industry is taking the best care of its horses and holding stakeholders accountable for their actions."

Thoroughbred Microchipping

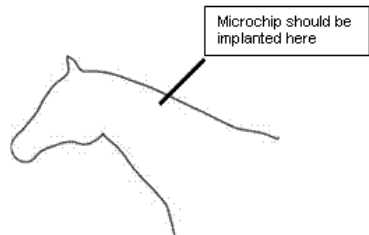
Answers to Frequently Asked Questions About Thoroughbred Microchipping:

1. Do Thoroughbreds in the United States, Canada, and Puerto Rico have to be microchipped?

Microchips are a requirement of registration for foals of 2017 and later.

2. How large is the microchip and where is it implanted in the horse?

The microchip is about the size of a grain of rice and is implanted in the nuchal ligament in the left side of the animal in the middle third of the neck.



3. What is the process of obtaining a microchip and implanting it into a Thoroughbred?

Microchips for registered Thoroughbreds born in 2016 and earlier can be purchased through The Jockey Club, or through your veterinarian or supplier. For foals of 2017, owners will be sent a free microchip with each registration and genetic sampling kit

The microchip should be implanted before or at the same time the DNA hair sample is collected, markings are recorded, and photos are taken. The horse identifier should always scan for a microchip and record the number when identifying a horse.

Before the microchip is implanted, the horse should be properly identified and checked for an existing microchip with a reader. The microchip to be implanted should be checked with a reader to make sure it is active and readable.

The microchip should be implanted in the nuchal ligament in the left side of the animal in the middle third of the neck. The veterinarian will prepare the site by clipping and scrubbing the area before implanting the microchip.

After the microchip has been implanted, it should be checked again with a reader to verify that it is still readable. Finally, the label from the microchip should be attached to the Registration Application or the information should be recorded to be reported to The Jockey Club.

4. Who implants the microchip?

The Jockey Club recommends that microchips be implanted by a veterinarian or under the supervision of a veterinarian.

5. What are the advantages of microchipping a Thoroughbred?

When used in conjunction with the official markings described on the Certificate of Foal Registration, microchips provide a convenient additional layer of confidence when establishing the identity of a Thoroughbred. Microchips may be helpful in establishing identity of Thoroughbreds involved in breeding operations, domestic or international travel, and in the event a horse is lost or stolen.

6. What type of microchip should I implant in my Thoroughbred, and where should I implant the chip?

The International Stud Book Committee (ISBC) has indicated that ISO 11784/11785 compliant microchips are to be inserted on the left side nuchal ligament of Thoroughbreds. Variations from this standard could result in the implant of another microchip.

7. How do I read the microchip in my Thoroughbred?

Microchips supplied by The Jockey Club can be read with an ISO 11785 compliant microchip reader. A number of other readers are also available from your veterinarian or veterinary supplier. You must ensure the reader you select is ISO 11785 compliant and can detect ISO compliant 11784 134.2 KHz radio frequency identification devices.

8. Can I acquire a microchip reader from The Jockey Club?

Datamars, Pet Travel is offering microchip scanners to Thoroughbred owners and breeders at a preferred price. Datamars manufactures the Datamars Microchip Scanner Compact Max and it is marketed and distributed by Pet Travel. The price for Thoroughbred owners and breeders will be \$249.00.

THE JOCKEY CLUB ADOPTS RULE REGARDING THOROUGHBRED STALLION BREEDINGS

The Jockey Club board of stewards announced May 7, 2020 that it has adopted a final rule limiting the annual breedings of individual stallions. The rule reflects The Jockey Club's goal to preserve the health of the Thoroughbred breed for the long term and will apply prospectively to stallions born in 2020 or later. Effective immediately, The Jockey Club's *Principal Rules and Requirements of the American Studbook* are amended by adding language to the text of Rule 14C

In part, the rule now states:

The total number of broodmares bred per individual stallion whose year of birth is 2020 or thereafter shall not exceed 140 per calendar year in the United States, Canada and Puerto Rico. The Jockey Club shall limit the number of Stallion Service Certificates for such stallion to a maximum of 140 per calendar year.

Reports of Mares Bred Due at The Jockey Club by August 1

The Jockey Club reminds stallion managers to submit their Reports of Mares Bred (RMBs) for the 2020 breeding season by August 1.

"To ensure that the breeding statistics we release in the fall are as accurate as possible, we request that RMBs be submitted by August 1," said Matt Iuliano, executive vice president and executive director of The Jockey Club. "In addition to the utility of covering information in mare produce records and catalog-style pedigrees available through equineline, the number of mares reported bred each year is an important economic indicator of the health of the Thoroughbred breeding industry."

Stallion managers who submit completed RMBs by August 1 are among the first to receive their Stallion Service Certificates, which facilitates the timely registration of 2021 foals.

Reports of Mares Bred may be submitted via Interactive Registration at registry.jockeyclub.com or a form is available by email, fax, or mail by contacting inquiries@jockeyclub.com.

9. If the owner of a microchipped Thoroughbred doesn't know its name or pedigree, can The Jockey Club help identify the horse using its microchip number?

If an owner knows the horse's microchip number and the microchip number has been reported to The Jockey Club, limited identification information on record with The Jockey Club about that horse can be obtained through Interactive Registration™ (IR) located at www.registry.jockeyclub.com. After logging on to IR, click on the Microchip Requesting, Reporting & Lookup banner in the Other Forms section on the right side of the page and follow the simple step-by-step instructions. Help screens are available. Identification information includes the horse's name (if named), year of birth, gender, color and dam's name.

10. Will The Jockey Club provide a horse's microchip number if the horse's name is provided?

No. A microchip number cannot be retrieved based on a horse's name.

11. How much does it cost to microchip a Thoroughbred?

There will be no costs to request a microchip for an unregistered foal born in 2016 or later; however, a fee may be incurred for replacement microchips.

For foals born in 2015 and earlier and registered foals of 2016 that were not microchipped prior to the completion of registration, microchips are available through The Jockey Club for \$15.00 per microchip, which includes shipping and handling. Kentucky and New York residents will also be charged applicable sales tax. There is no fee to report a microchip number to The Jockey Club. Your veterinarian may charge a fee for their services.

12. Can microchip numbers be reported to The Jockey Club by phone?

No. Microchip numbers can be reported to The Jockey Club only through Interactive Registration™ (IR). If you do not have access to IR, please call the Registry for assistance at (800) 444-8521.

13. What if a mistake was made when reporting a microchip number to The Jockey Club?

If a mistake was made when reporting a microchip number to The Jockey Club, the owner should send a written, signed statement to The Jockey Club indicating the name of the horse and the incorrect microchip number. Once The Jockey Club invalidates the number, the owner can report the correct microchip number via Interactive Registration™. For registered foals whose microchip number has been recorded in the markings section of their Certificate of Foal Registration, a request to correct the certificate must be submitted to The Jockey Club.

14. Are Thoroughbreds microchipped in other countries?

Yes, a number of countries around the world microchip Thoroughbreds, including Great Britain, Ireland, France, Japan, Germany, South Africa, and Australia.

15. What kind of microchips is The Jockey Club selling?

Microchips available from The Jockey Club are ISO 11784-compliant. These microchips contain a unique, 15-character number.

16. Once I have implanted the microchip from The Jockey Club, what other steps are required?

Once the microchip is implanted, you should log on to Interactive Registration™ (IR) and report the microchip number using the online Microchip Requesting, Reporting & Lookup module. Microchip numbers are not associated with a specific horse until reported to The Jockey Club by the owner or breeder. If you do not have access to IR, please call the Registry for assistance at (800) 444-8521.

17. Can I purchase a microchip from The Jockey Club for my non-Thoroughbred horse?

The Jockey Club sells microchips only to customers who have conducted registration-related activity with the Registry. Thoroughbred owners or breeders who have horses of other breeds on the same premises should consult the responsible breed authority for specific information on microchipping those breeds
