Oaklawn 2024-2025 - Right Around the Corner!

Oaklawn's first Condition Book has been released. If you haven't received a copy it is available on-line at Oaklawn.com. Ten overnight stakes have been added to this meet's stakes program, each having a purse of \$145,000. Including those ten races, there will be a total of 57 stakes races during the 2024-2025 meet. Allowance purses will start at \$130,000 with Maiden purses at \$110,000.

The first Condition Book for the 2024-2025 meet covers the first thirteen days of racing, two of those days being in 2025. One restricted Arkansasbred race is written for each day, three of those days are for 2 year olds. In addition to the races in the condition books, the racing office writes extras that are printed in the daily overnight sheets. These offer additional opportunities for your horses to be entered if the conditions are conducive for any of them.

ATBHA is again offering the Bonus Purse Supplement for the 2024-2025 Oaklawn live meet. This bonus is paid to the owner of registered Arkansasbreds who finish 1st, 2nd or 3rd in open company races (excluding stakes and handicaps). This program started in 2015 with ATBHA paying only \$12,000 that year, 2016 grew to \$50,000 and it's been increasing every year since. In 2022, the year December racing began, bonuses totaled \$71,000, followed by \$166,000 in 2023. \$135,000 was paid for Jan-May 2024 and will increase by the December bonus money that will be paid. This program has grown tremendously over the years. Why? Because Arkansas breeders are breeding and raising better Arkansas-breds that can hold their own against thoroughbreds from other areas of the United States.

Mares Bred Reports were due <u>August 1st</u>. If you are a stallion owner or breeding farm and have not yet filed yours, please file with The Jockey Club immediately and send a copy to ATBHA!

NOTICE TO BREEDERS of Arkansas-bred Foals

When registering your Arkansas-bred foals with ATBHA, please include The Jockey Club number in the appropriate blank on the ATBHA Application. If your foal has been reported on a Live Foal Report, that Jockey Club number is listed on that completed form. It is a seven digit number of which the first two numbers will be the year your foal is born, ie. 2024 foals will begin with 24 followed by five numbers issued by The Jockey Club.

So, when you submit a completed application to the ATBHA office to register your Arkansas-bred foal, the only blank that should not be filled in, most commonly, would be the blank for the foal's name. All other information is available and should be filled in.

BROODMARE REGISTRATIONS Register broodmares <u>immediately</u> upon bringing them into Arkansas. Broodmares MUST BE registered <u>PRIOR TO FOALING.</u>

It is imperative that you register your FOALS with A.T.B.H.A. & The Jockey Club showing the Breeder(s) exactly the same on both registrations

When ATBHA receives The Jockey Club's information at the end of the year to calculate your Breeder award, their information needs to match the way the foal was registered with ATBHA so the award is paid correctly.

A foal born in the State of Arkansas <u>and</u> whose dam and sire are both correctly registered with ATBHA <u>or</u> whose dam is correctly registered with ATBHA <u>and</u> whose sire is not a registered Arkansas stallion, but all ATBHA breedback rules to the dam have been fulfilled is a <u>**Registered Arkansas-bred Foal**</u>.

Failure to provide the form and fee, as outlined above, can result in your horse not being eligible to start in the race.

ATBHA RULES & REGULATIONS FOR STALLIONS STANDING IN ARKANSAS

Owners of registered Arkansas stallions must submit a Report of Mares Bred to The Jockey Club on or before August 1st following the breeding season, listing all mares bred to the stallion during that year's breeding season, as required by The Jockey Club Rules and Regulations. A copy of said Report of Mares Bred must be submitted to the ATBHA office by August 1, accompanied by the applicable annual stallion re-certification fee.

To renew a stallion's Arkansas registration, an annual re-certification fee shall be paid on each registered Arkansas stallion that stood in Arkansas <u>only</u> during that year's breeding season. Payment of the annual Stallion Re-certification Fee shall be the obligation of the stallion owner, shall be in the amount of three hundred dollars (\$300) per year, beginning the year after the initial Arkansas registration, shall be due and payable to ATBHA on or before August 1st of the breeding year, and shall be accompanied by a photocopy of the Report of Mares Bred for that year, as set out in Section above. FROM THE ATBHA OFFICE

July was an abnormally busy month in our ATBHA office. We purchased a new computer, a new cellular telephone system (we do not yet have access to fiber optics), and switched to the on-line version of our bookkeeping system! I'm still learning!!! The last two saved us money. It wasn't planned for these to come at the same time, but that's how it happened! Our computer was over ten years old and too full of information!!! If you are in possession of an awards check that you have not cashed or deposited, please do one or the other so it will clear our Purse & Awards account. If your name was on one of the lists in the 2nd quarter newsletter and you haven't received your check(s), please let the ATBHA office know. We have quite a few checks outstanding!!!

When stamping the digital Jockey Club Certificates for 2023 foals, I found 19 foals registered with The Jockey Club that were foaled in Arkansas, but that were not registered with ATBHA. One of those is not eligible for registration. I contacted the Breeders on the remaining 18. Twelve have been recently registered, paying the yearling rate. Three are in suppose to be getting their applications to me. I am waiting for the remaining three to get back to me. If I don't hear from them soon, I'll try again. We don't know these foals even exist until their Jockey Club registrations are completed and the digital certificate is on line and available to be stamped with the State bred stamp. Don't be one of those that has to pay the late registration fees. It's pretty simple: \$40 weanling foal registration vs. \$200 yearling registration! If the foal's dam isn't registered, that's another \$500. All Arkansas registrations are due by December 31st of their foaling year. So, in December of each year, make it a habit to verify that all of your registrations are complete for that year, then you won't have to pay those higher fees. If you aren't sure, call the ATBHA office and we can look it up and let you know if it's complete or whether you still need to get it done!

Please fill out and return the Questionnaire to the right so we can update your membership information, even if you don't have a stallion or farm. We need to keep your mailing address, telephone number(s), email, etc. up to date so we can contact you if we find you have a missing registration that may cost you added fees if you don't act soon.
