In Memoriam


Deana Echols

Deana Lee Echols, 76, of Hot Springs, entered Heaven on May 11, 2025. She was born April 16, 1949 in Hot Springs to Arlie and Virginia Payne.

Deana started her professional career as a legal secretary in 1980. She was awarded the honor of Legal Secretary of the year in 1985. She later assumed the role of executive secretary of the Arkansas Thoroughbred Breeders Association. Her love for horse racing began as a child, as her parents were involved in the thoroughbred industry. Deana was known to many as "Deeda", a name given to her by her grandson. In her free time, she loved being at her houseboat on Lake Ouachita, where she spent time with her family and friends on S-Dock. Deana loved to entertain others, and took great pride in sharing her culinary talents with everyone. Deana's cakes were the highlight of the occasion, and were always made with love. Around Christmas, she was well known for baking homemade Christmas cookies with her daughter, a tradition that had been passed down for 3 generations. She had a green thumb and enjoyed raising flowers and plants. The Razorbacks were her team. Didn't matter the sport. If they were playing she was tuned in and cheering them on.

She is predeceased by her parents; her husband Charles Ray Echols, the father of her children who passed away after a tragic accident in 1991, and her dear companion of 23 years, Donnie Koller.

ATBHA Rules & Regulations for Stallions Standing in Arkansas

Owners of registered Arkansas stallions must submit a Report of Mares bred to the Jockey Club on or before August 1 following the breeding season, listing all mares bred to the stallion during the season, as required by the Jockey Club Rules & Regulations. A copy of said Report of Mares Bred must be submitted to the ATBHA office by August 1, accompanied by the applicable annual stallion re-certification fee.

To renew a stallion's Arkansas registration, an annual re-certification fee shall be paid on each registered Arkansas stallion that stood in Arkansas only during that year's breeding season. Payment of the annual Stallion re-certification fee shall be the obligation of the stallion owner, shall be in the amount of \$300 per year, beginning the year after the initial Arkansas registration, shall be due and payable to the ATBHA on or before August 1 of the breeding year, and shall be accompanied by a photocopy of the Report of Mares Bred for that year.



In Memoriam D. Wayne Lukas

D. Wayne Lukas was one of the most influential horse trainers in American racing history, and his impact is deeply felt in Arkansas. As the longtime king of Oaklawn Park, Lukas brought national attention to Hot Springs during the 1980s and 1990s, regularly showcasing some of the best horses in the country. His willingness to run champions in Arkansas not only elevated the quality of competition but also attracted national media and fans, cementing Oaklawn as a proving ground for horses on the road to the Triple Crown. His dominance helped transform Oaklawn from a regional track into a nationally respected racing destination.

Beyond his victories, Lukas reshaped the racing culture in Arkansas by raising the standard of excellence and inspiring a new generation of horsemen. His success and presence gave credibility to Oaklawn's stakes program and helped ensure that top barns across the country would target Arkansas preps for the Kentucky Derby. To this day, his legacy is reflected in the prestige of Oaklawn's racing season and in the countless trainers and fans who were drawn to the sport because of the excitement and innovation he brought to Arkansas racing.

It is imperative that you register your **FOALS** with **A.T.B.H.A. & The Jockey Club** showing the **Breeder(s)** exactly the same on both registrations.

When **ATBHA** receives **The Jockey Club's** information at the end of the year to calculate your **Breeder award**, their information needs to match the way the foal was registered with **ATBHA** so the award is paid correctly.
